Additionally, two NLUJ students with impairments will receive yearly internships from Luthra and Luthra Law Offices.

A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) has been signed by the Rajiv K. Luthra Foundation and National Law University, Jodhpur (NLUJ) to create the Rajiv K. Luthra-NLUJ Accessibility Lab on the university campus, with the goal of promoting accessible legal education and disability inclusion.

In addition to promoting research and policy activities in the areas of disability rights and

accessibility, the Lab will concentrate on improving access to educational resources through assistive technologies.

The facility will be a cutting-edge accessibility hub and operational by February 2026. It is currently intended to accommodate students with visual, auditory, locomotor, learning, and other disabilities through academic and infrastructural aid.
